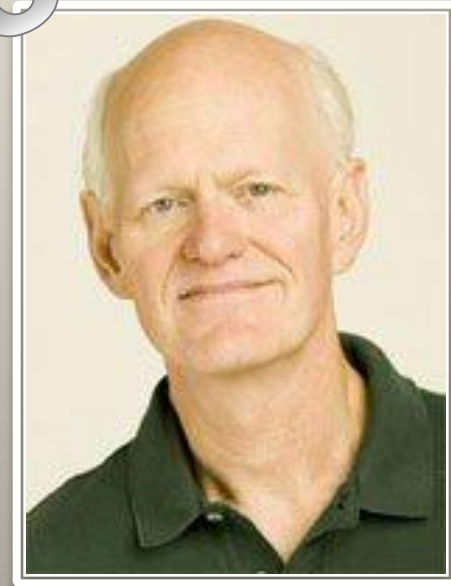

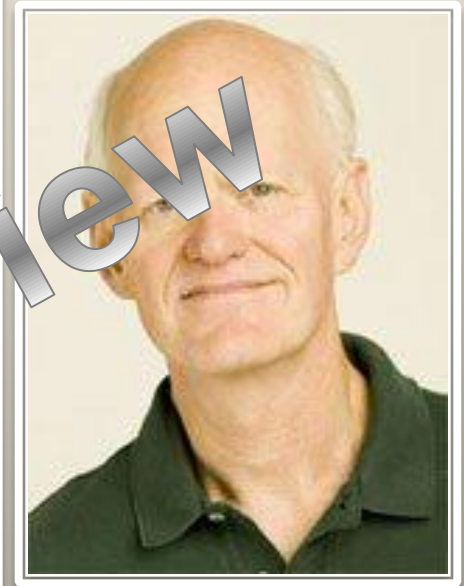

At one level it could be about winning. At the next level, maybe it’s about not winning, letting other people win.”

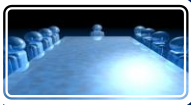

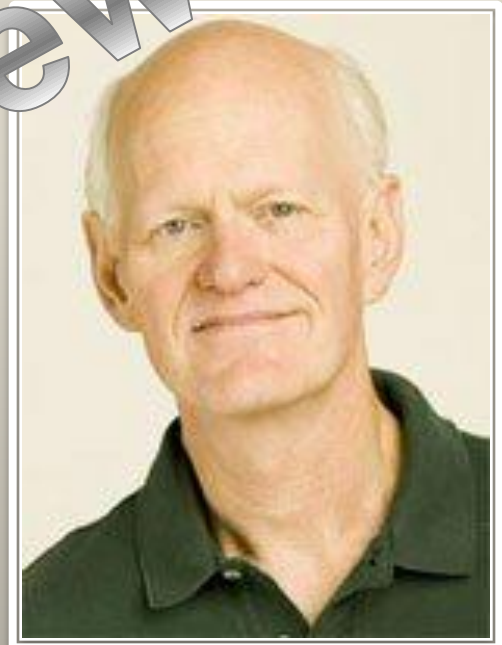

Behavior change for leaders with expanding roles

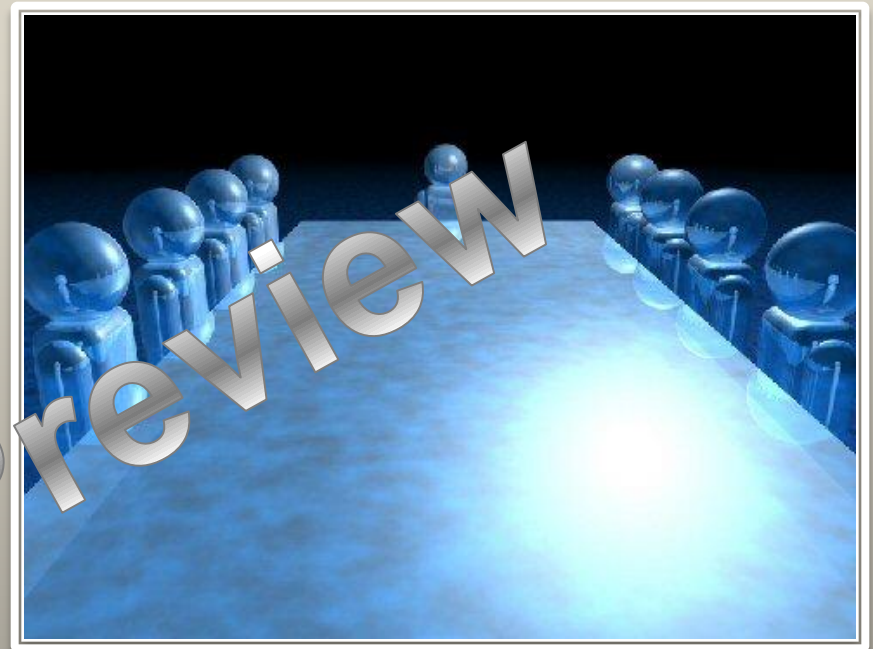
- ✓ Find a leader or leaders you admire.
- ✓ Identify character traits they have that you want to develop.
- ✓ Know the behavior your next job requires.
- ✓ Find what motivates your team to perform.



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Listening skills and motivation by not “adding too much value.”

- ✓ Actively solicit and listen to ideas or solutions to problems.
- ✓ Refrain from commenting or editing good ideas.
- ✓ Let the team take ownership and execute on their idea or solution to a problem.
- ✓ Track their success and commitment to execution.



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Ask for Feedback

- ✓ Ask for feedback on how you can improve as a leader.
- ✓ Listen without comment.
- ✓ Reflect and think before speaking.
- ✓ Thank people for their time and feedback.
- ✓ Select a trait you want to improve.
- ✓ Follow up and ask each month how you're doing.
- ✓ Let every member of your team do this process also.



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Avoid Favoritism

- ✓ Rank and order your direct reports on how much you think they like you.
- ✓ Rank how much they are like you.
- ✓ Rank direct reports on their contribution to the company and customers.
- ✓ Rank who you give the most *unqualified* positive recognition.
- ✓ Notice any mis-match.



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Team building without time wasting or "FeedForward"

- ✓ Team ranks itself on a scale of 1-10 (10 is the highest), on how well it's working together.
- ✓ Team ranks how well it thinks it should be doing.
- ✓ Team lists two behaviors it needs to improve.
- ✓ Select the most important.
- ✓ Each team member selects one behavior s/he wants to improve for the future.
- ✓ Each person quickly asks another person how s/he can improve upon his/her individual goal and the team's goal.
- ✓ Do this every month.



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Winning too much

- ✓ How much does being right help or hurt our relationships?
- ✓ Are you missing good ideas by not listening?
- ✓ Are you right?
- ✓ Is it worth it?



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Destructive Comments

- ✓ Bad comments derail “team,” “synergy” and “win/win.”
- ✓ Break the habit of making bad comments about our co-workers
- ✓ How to do it?
- ✓ Pay a fine!
